Drop-In Child Care Now at Bow Creek Rec Center

- Parent must remain in the center

Rates

- \$5 per child per visit; or
- \$20 per child for a monthly pass; requires a credit/debit card written notice to cancel

Hours

- Monday - Thursday 8 - 11 a.m. & 4:30 - 8:30 pm
- Friday: 8 - 11 a.m.
- Saturday: 9 a.m. - 12 noon
- Children can stay in Drop-In Child Care up to 2 hours per day.

City Council Information

The 11- member City Council is the City's governing body. Council members serve four-year terms and are elected on a staggered basis. General elections are held the Tuesday following the first Monday in November in *even-numbered* years. All registered voters are eligible to vote for all members of City Council.

Three council members and the Mayor serve "At Large" with no district residency requirement. All other council members are required to live in the districts they represent: Bayside, Beach, Centerville, Kempsville, Lynnhaven, Princess Anne, and Rose Hall.
