

Who is My Council Representative?

Due to the March 19 Virginia Beach Circuit Court order and the resignation of Council Member Shannon Kane, the Beach District and Rose Hall District City Council seats were recently vacant. State code authorizes the City Council to fill vacancies until a special election is held; in this case, on the first Tuesday in November.

Guy King Tower, a retired attorney, mediator, educator and association executive, was appointed to the Beach seat in April.

City Council will interview selected Rose Hall candidates during a public special session on May 7, and immediately following the interviews, the City Council will deliberate and make a decision.

Virginia Beach Residents Eligible for Flood Insurance Discounts

The Federal Emergency Management Agency/National Flood Insurance Program's Community Rating System (CRS), a voluntary program started nearly 30 years ago, encourages and rewards communities' efforts to go beyond basic requirements to mitigate flooding. The CRS uses a 10-level (or point) scale to evaluate efforts and each level below 10 receives a 5% discount on flood insurance premiums. The City will join the program as a Class 7 community, which means residents and business owners in highrisk flood zones can now save 15% on flood insurance premiums for policies initiated or renewed on or after May 1, 2019.

Properties located outside the high-risk flood zones are eligible for Preferred Risk Policies, which means they are already receiving a lower rate. For more information on the rating system, visit FloodSmart.gov.

Waze Connected Citizens Program

Virginia Beach has joined the Waze Connected Citizens Program, an everyday driving platform that brings together drivers to outsmart traffic. The program is a free, two-way data share of publicly available traffic information that promotes greater efficiency and safer roads by giving local citizens a greater ability to circumvent road closures and traffic jams within the Waze app.

Waze provides partners with real-time, anonymous, Waze-generated incident and slow-down information directly from drivers. In exchange, Virginia

Beach provides real-time governmentreported construction and crash and road closure data to Waze. The combined result is one of the most succinct, thorough overviews of current road conditions available.

During emergency situations, Waze also allows users to search for nearby shelters and open gas stations, as well as utilize an SOS button to call on other Waze users for roadside assistance. Virginia Beach can provide users with advanced notice of flooded roadways during inclement weather and situation awareness during major traffic events such as marathons. festivals. parades and holiday weekends that may affect their regular routes.
